TRANSPORT



Air

Edinburgh International Airport has regular scheduled services to many UK and International destinations. The airport is approximately 30 minutes from the University. There is a frequent and reliable Airport Bus from the Airport to the city centre (£5.00 return approx).

Car

Edinburgh is well connected to the UK trunk road and motorway network. The Central Area of the University is based around Chambers Street, Nicholson Street and from the North by following North Bridge into South Bridge.

From the South: From M6 head on to A74/M74 J13

From the West: Turn off at M8 J15, A8 then head onto A8

From the North: From M90 J11 then continue straight onto A90. Please refer to www.multimap for more information.
